- Assist Program Coordinator in Program support (education, employment, training, child protection work with other duties)
- Work with suppliers and ensure stocks are well organized.
- Contact relevant focal authorizes agencies to ensure compliance.
- Work and share knowledge with colleagues from Cambodia, Thailand, Laos and Indonesia.
