

TERMS OF REFERENCE

IT Consultant for Web Development

INTRODUCTION

The Partnership Program for the Protection of Children (3PC) is powered by the Ministry of Social Affairs, Veterans and Youth, technically supported by UNICEF, coordinated by Friends-International and implemented by more than 20 I/NGO's across eight provinces in Cambodia. The network strives to strengthen the child protection system in Cambodia through improved coordination, collaboration and capacity building to save lives and build futures of children, youth and their families. Together, 3PC reached 25,504 children, 5,902 youth and 17,561 caregivers with services in 2021.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this assignment is for the contractor to develop an online interactive catalogue for professionals working in the employment sector (not end users) who will use this catalogue to help beneficiaries (future students) find targeted training or employment support.

SCOPE OF WORK

The consultant will work closely with the Vocational Training (VT) mapping team at Friends-International (FI). The consultant will need to:

- select the best website development and hosting method (public website with limited number of users);
- based on vision of FI, design clickable map (dynamic content) by province;
- insert links for all service providers to show service detail (approx. 200 pages including null answer page) including logos
- insert three search parameters: skill type, institution and province

Website will be developed in English but we would need a functionality that could allow for a two-language catalogue.

It must be user friendly, dynamic and easy to update.

DELIVERABLES

The final product is an online interactive catalogue for professionals working in employment promoting access to over 200 Vocational Training and Employment service providers.

TIMEFRAME

The work is expected to be carried out over two months: August and September 2021. Final deliverable must be submitted on 30th September 2021.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested candidates should submit a CV with a cover letter and an initial quotation for this work to hr@friends-international.org. Companies are also welcome to submit their offers that should include a quotation.

Deadline for sending applications is **1st of August, 2021**.
