#### **Significant Accounting Policies**

Friends adopts the following accounting policies in the preparation of its financial statements.

#### **Basis of Preparation**

The financial statements are expressed in the presentational currency - US\$ and are prepared in accordance with a modified cash basis of accounting. Under this basis of accounting, income is recognized when funds are received rather than when they are 'earned' and expenditure is recognized when payments are made rather than when they are incurred, with the exception of FI Suisse and except for the following treatments elsewhere:

- Advances are initially recognized as a current asset in the Statement of Financial Position, until liquidation with supporting documents, at which point they are recognized as expenses in the Income Statement.
- Deposits to suppliers, loans to staff and other advances are recorded as Accounts Receivables in the Statement of Financial Position until these balances are settled.
- Salary tax payable withheld from staff salaries are recorded as Income Tax Payable in the Statement of Financial Position until payments have been made to relevant tax authorities.
- The costs of fixed assets are charged to expenses upon acquisition. For control and management purposes, a fixed asset register is maintained.

#### **Foreign Currency Translation**

Friends executes transactions primarily in the local currency of each program office. Functional currencies are as follows:

In 2021 each program office maintained its records in their primary currency. Transactions in currencies other than the primary currency are converted into the primary currency at the rate of exchange prevailing on the transaction dates. Exchange differences are recognized in the Income Statement.

#### Consolidation

The consolidated financial statements of the Friends Alliance group are prepared by the FI Headquarters and are unaudited. All intra-group balances, transactions, income and expenses are eliminated in full.

# A Message from Us

The second year into the pandemic has been one of overcoming paradoxical challenges. Maintaining proximity to our beneficiaries while social distancing. Amplifying our crucial

and life-saving outreach efforts while in lockdowns and curfews. Preserving children's education when schools and education centres shut down. Retaining students in vocational training while training centres are closed "until further notice". Providing sustenance, hope and food security to families that have fundamentally lost their self-sustainability in its entirety.

77,886 beneficiaries served

\$60.48 cost per beneficiary

Friends' #everydayheroes did not shy away from the daunting responsibilities that lay ahead. With adaptability, determination and courage, Friends persevered reaching 77,886 individuals across 9 cities; with each location presenting its own unique challenges both COVID and non-COVID related. How did we do it? Soup kitchens, meal

preparation and distribution, emergency

food and material package deliveries to families, education hotlines, homework distributions, online vocational trainings, mobilisation of our trained and dedicated ChildSafe Agents, and the list goes on.

Predictably, our vocational training business income plummeted to a mere \$243K (↓91% since the preparation pandemic era), resulting in a severe decrease in our financial sustainability,

\$2.4M sales revenue foregone since 2019

down to 4% compared to 39% in 2019. We were tremendously fortunate to acquire \$7m from multiple institutional and private donors (↑49% since 2019). We are grateful to all our funders for their commitment, encouragement and understanding of these testing circumstances and our moving targets.

40/0 financial sustainability

Our vocational training business costs also plunged to only \$131K (\$\strict\$87% since 2019). Our largest cost increase in absolute value was sub-grants to our ChildSafe Alliance partners (\$\strict\$146% since 2019). Multiple sub-grants were provided to a total of 23 partners in Cambodia, the Philippines, Malaysia and Jordan. Our UNICEF-funded 3PC network saw 3 additional implementing partners, and we further supported 6 new

Cambodian partners' efforts in emergency response. Unsurprisingly, our own emergency family support costs skyrocketed by \$242K / 187% from 2020. This is a 1157% / \$350K increase from 2019. Likewise, meal provisions went

up by 151% / \$166K from 2020, attributable to the emergency meal distributions in Phnom Penh, Myanmar and Laos. Employment support more

than doubled from 2020, however, 66% of that spending was in the latter part of 2021, when lockdowns started easing. Similarly, 75% of school reintegration support was also in the last quarter of 2021 when schools finally re-opened, and we saw our costs increase by \$29K / 64% from 2020, in line with our increase in children reintegrated to public schools.



Overall, we've seen a radical shift in our entire income portfolio, and our expense composition. Saving Lives has required an increasing injection of funds for prevention and emergency response. And consequently, an even bigger investment in Building Futures is necessary to re-build and secure disrupted livelihoods, especially due to the loss of our self-generated income.

Considering these intensified needs for the immediate and long-term sustainability of our beneficiaries, we anticipate team growth in all sectors: outreach, education, vocational training, and employment. As borders in the region start to unlock, and we re-learn normality, Friends endeavours to continue saving lives and building futures with an aspirational budget of \$8.5m for 2022.





























# 2021 Expenses Equivalent to 2012
